Description	Pneumococcal pneumonia is a type of bacterial pneumonia that is caused by Streptococcus pneumoniae (which is also called pneumococcus). It is the most common bacterial pneumonia found in adults, the most common type of community-acquired pneumonia, and one of the common types of pneumococcal infection. The estimated number of Americans with pneumococcal pneumonia is 900, 000 annually, with almost 400, 000 cases hospitalized and fatalities accounting for 5-7% of these cases.

Application	Immunogen, WB, ELISA
Storage	Store the lyophilized powder at 4 centigrade for 6 months. It is recommended to aliquote to ~10ul per vial and store at -20 centigrade for long term storage. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles.
Storage Buffer	Powder or 0.1M PBS, PH 7.0
