Description	Haemophilus influenzae (formerly called Pfeiffer's bacillus or Bacillus influenzae) is a Gram-negative, coccobacillary, facultatively anaerobic pathogenic bacterium belonging to the Pasteurellaceae family. H. influenzae was first described in 1892 by Richard Pfeiffer during an influenza pandemic.

Application	Immunogen, WB, ELISA
Storage	Store the lyophilized powder at 4 centigrade for 6 months. It is recommended to aliquote to ~10ul per vial and store at -20 centigrade for long term storage. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles.
Storage Buffer	Powder or 0.1M PBS, PH 7.0
