Description	Oleate hydratase (OhyA) is a bacterial flavoenzyme from Staphylococcus aureus that catalyzes the addition of water to fatty acid carbon-carbon double bonds. It plays a crucial role in inactivating antimicrobial unsaturated fatty acids, countering the host's innate immune response. Oleate hydratases are also of interest in industrial applications, particularly for producing high-value products like 10-hydroxy stearic acid, which can replace other chemicals in the chemical and pharmaceutical industries.
