Stability	Upon arrival, the lyophilized protein may be stored for 2 weeks at 4 centigrade. For

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long term storage, it is recommended to store desiccated below -20 centigrade in a manual defrost freezer. Following reconstitution, the protein may be stored for 2 weeks under sterile conditions at -20 centigrade. For long term storage, it is recommended to make appropriate aliquots and store at -80 centigrade. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage Store at -20 centigrade.

Reconstitution Briefly spin the vial and bring the contents to the bottom prior to opening. It is recommended to reconstitute at 0.5-1 mg/mL with sterile deionized water.

Shipping Ambient temperature.
