Product Overview	Recombinant Human ADPRH protein, fused to His-tag, was expressed in E.coli and purified by Ni-sepharose.

Description	The enzyme encoded by this gene catalyzes removal of mono-ADP-ribose from arginine residues of proteins in the ADP-ribosylation cycle. Unlike the rat and mouse enzymes, which require DTT for maximal activity, the human enzyme is DTT-independent.

Storage	The protein is stored in PBS buffer at -20°C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles.
Storage Buffer	1M PBS (58mM Na ₂ HPO ₄ , 17mM NaH ₂ PO ₄ , 68mM NaCl, pH8.) added with 300mM Imidazole and 0.7% Sarcosyl, 15% glycerol.
