Description	This gene encodes an enzyme responsible for the catalytic conversion of UTP (uridine triphosphate) to CTP (cytidine triphosphate). This reaction is an important step in the biosynthesis of phospholipids and nucleic acids. Activity of this protein is important in the immune system, and loss of function of this gene has been associated with immunodeficiency. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants.

Notes	Instruction of use: This knockdown cell lysate should be paired with wild-type 293T cell lysate for use. For Western blotting, we recommend running wild-type and knockdown lysates on the same gel, and loading each well with equal volume and equal amount of total proteins.
