Product Overview	Mouse PD-1 Protein, His Tag is expressed from human 293 cells (HEK293). It contains AA Leu 25-Gln 167 (Accession # Q02242-1). This protein carries a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus. Predicted N-terminus: Leu 25

Description	Programmed cell death protein 1 (PD-1) is also known as CD279 and PDCD1, is a type I membrane protein and is a member of the extended CD28/CTLA-4 family of T cell regulators. PDCD1 is expressed on the surface of activated T cells, B cells, macrophages, myeloid cells and a subset of thymocytes. PD-1 has two ligands, PD-L1 and PD-L2, which are members of the B7 family. PD-L1 is expressed on almost all murine tumor cell lines, including PA1 myeloma, P815 mastocytoma, and B16 melanoma upon treatment with IFN-γ. PD-L2 expression is more restricted and is expressed mainly by DCs and a few tumor lines. PD1 inhibits the T-cell proliferation and production of related cytokines including IL-1, IL-4, IL-10 and IFN-γ by suppressing the activation and transduction of PI3K/AKT pathway. In addition, coligation of PD1 inhibits BCR-mediating signal by dephosphorylating key signal transducer. In vitro, treatment of anti-CD3 stimulated T cells with PD-L1-Ig results in reduced T cell proliferation and IFN-γ secretion. Monoclonal antibodies targeting PD-1 that boost the immune system are being developed for the treatment of cancer.

Form	Lyophilized from 0.22 µm filtered solution in PBS, pH7.4 with trehalose as protectant.
Bio-activity	Immobilized Mouse PD-1 Protein, His Tag at 1 µg/mL (100 µL/well) can bind Nofazinlimab with a linear range of 0.1-2 ng/mL.
Molecular Mass	The protein has a calculated MW of 18.0 kDa. The protein migrates as 35-40 kDa when calibrated against Star Ribbon Pre-stained Protein Marker under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE) due to glycosylation.
Endotoxin	Less than 1.0 EU/µg by the LAL method/rFC method.
Purity	>90% as determined by SDS-PAGE. >95% as determined by SEC-MALS.
Storage	This product is stable after storage at: -20 to -70 centigrade for 12 months in lyophilized state; -70 centigrade for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution. For long term storage, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20 centigrade or lower. Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 µg/µL. Centrifuge the vial at 4 centigrade before opening to recover the entire contents.

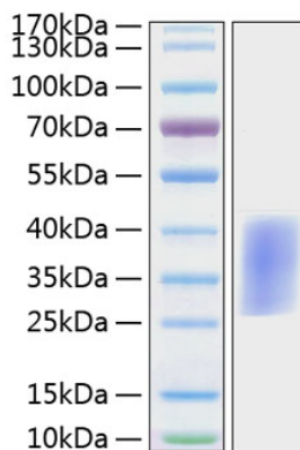
