Product Overview	Mouse ALPI Protein, His Tag is expressed from human 293 cells (HEK293). It contains AA Ile 20 - Pro 503 (Accession # Q0VD75). This protein carries a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus. Predicted N-terminus: Ile 20. The protein is designed as a dimer.

Description	There are at least four distinct but related alkaline phosphatases: intestinal, placental, placental-like, and liver/bone/kidney (tissue non-specific). The intestinal alkaline phosphatase gene encodes a digestive brush-border enzyme. This enzyme is a component of the gut mucosal defense system and is thought to function in the detoxification of lipopolysaccharide, and in the prevention of bacterial translocation in the gut.
Form	Supplied as 0.2 µm filtered solution in 20 mM Tris, 150 mM NaCl, 20% Glycerol, pH7.5 with trehalose as protectant.
Bio-activity	Immobilized Mouse ALPI Protein, His Tag at 5 µg/mL (100 µL/well) can bind various dilution ratio of Anti-ALPP/ALPG/ALPI Polyclonal Antibody.
Molecular Mass	The protein has a calculated MW of 54.2 kDa. The protein migrates as 65-80 kDa

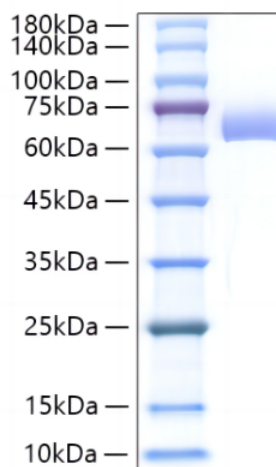
