Description	Xeno-free Activin AHuXp is a member of the TGF beta superfamily, expressed from human 293 cells as disulfide linked homodimer with an apparent molecular mass of 25 kDa. This cytokine is produced in a serum-free, chemically defined media. The purity is greater than 95%.
Activity	0.5 to 5 ng/mL ED50.
Purity	>95%.
Endotoxin	Endotoxin-free.
Molecular Mass	25 kDa, homodimer, nonglycosylated.
Purity Confirmation	The protein was resolved by SDS polyacrylamide gel electrophoresis and the gel was stained with Coomassie blue.
Activity Assay	The specific activity was determined by the dose-dependent inhibition of proliferation of the MPC-11 cell line (mouse plasmocytoma cell line).
