Product Overview	Recombinant human HIPK1 (156-555aa) was expressed in <i>Sf21 cell</i> using an N-terminal GST tag.

Source	Sf21 Cells
Protein Length	156-555 a.a.
Description	The protein encoded by this gene belongs to the Ser/Thr family of protein kinases and HIPK subfamily. It phosphorylates homeodomain transcription factors and may also function as a co-repressor for homeodomain transcription factors. Alternative splicing results in four transcript variants encoding four distinct isoforms.
Purity	90%.
Unit Definition	1 unit equals 1 nanogram of purified protein.
Buffer	Recombinant protein stored in 50mM Tris-HCl, pH 7.5, 150mM NaCl, 0.25mM DTT, 0.1mM EGTA, 0.1mM EDTA, 0.1mM PMSF, 25% glycerol.
Storage	Store product at -70°C . For optimal storage, aliquot target into smaller quantities after centrifugation and store at recommended temperature. For most favorable performance, avoid repeated handling and multiple freeze/thaw cycles.
