Activity	Measured by its ability to bind the complex of Artemin-GFR α 3 in a functional ELISA. Serial dilution of immobilized rhRet (100 μ L/well) was tested for binding with rmArtemin (10 ng/mL) in the presence of rhGFR α 3/Fc (2 μ g/mL). The ED50 of the immobilized Ret in this assay is typically 2 - 6 μ g/mL.
Resuspension	Resuspend in 1 % NH ₄ OH, at a concentration of 1 mg/ml. Sonicate for 30 seconds to 1 minute after it has gone into solution. To bring it into your buffer: After resuspension, add 5x or 10x buffer stock and water, to bring to 1x buffer.
