Product Overview	Recombinant human SP1 protein was expressed in <i>Sf9 insect cells</i> .

Description	SP1 belongs to the family of zinc finger DNA binding proteins in mammalian cells. This protein mediates transcriptional activity through specific DNA sequences that are found in a number of viral and cellular gene promoters. SP1 has been shown to associate with other mammalian gene coactivator proteins to regulate gene transcription.
Formulation	15 ug of recombinant SP1 protein in 5uM ZnSO ₄ , 50 mM KCl, 2mM DTT, 12 mM HEPES-KOH (pH 7.5), 6 mM MgCl ₂ , 0.1% NP40 and 50% glycerol.
Applications	Useful for the stimulation of LSD1 enzyme activity.
Storage	Store at -70° C. Avoid multiple freeze/thaw cycles.
Pathways	Huntington"s disease; TGF-beta signaling pathway
