Product Overview	Recombinant Mouse C1qtnf9 produced in <i>E. coli</i> . The mouse CTRP9 (C1q tumor necrosis factor- α -related protein 9) (aa 195-333) is fused at the N-terminus to a His-tag.

Description	Adiponectin is a major insulin-sensitizing, multimeric hormone derived from adipose tissue that acts on muscle and liver to regulate whole-body glucose and lipid metabolism. Here, we describe a novel and highly conserved paralog of adiponectin designated as C1q/TNF-related protein (CTRP) 9. Of all the CTRP paralogs, CTRP9 shows the highest degree of amino acid identity to adiponectin in its globular C1q domain. CTRP9 is expressed predominantly in adipose tissue and females express higher levels of the transcript than males.

Formulation	Liquid. 0.2 μ m-filtered solution in 55mM Tris-Cl, pH 8.2, containing 150mM NaCl.

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LongTerm Storage	-20°C.
Handling	After opening, prepare aliquots and store at -20°C. Avoid freeze/thaw cycles.
Stability	Working aliquots are stable for up to 3 months when stored at -20°C.
