Product Overview	Recombinant human CCL27 protein was expressed in <i>E.coli</i> and purified by using conventional chromatography techniques. 10.3 kDa (89aa).

Description	Cutaneous T cell-attracting chemokine CCL27 is a member of the chemokine superfamily and the subfamily of β r C-C chemokines that binds chemokine receptor CCR10. Chemokines are a superfamily of small secreted proteins that attract their targets by interacting with G protein-coupled receptors expressed on the migrating cell. CCL27 is involved in the preferential migration and recruitment of cutaneous lymphocyte-associated antigen CLA ⁺ memory lymphocytes.
Form	Liquid. In 10 mM Sodium Citrate (pH 3.5), containing 10% Glycerol.
Purity	> 95% by SDS - PAGE.
Concentration	0.5 mg/ml (determined by Bradford assay).
Endotoxin Level	< 1.0 EU per 1 μ g of protein (determined by LAL method).

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Storage

Can be stored at +4°C short term (1-2 weeks). For long term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or -70°C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles.
