Product Overview	Recombinant human MAT1A protein, fused to His-tag at N-terminus, was expressed in <i>E.coli</i> and purified by using conventional chromatography techniques, 45.6 kDa (414aa).

Description	MAT1A catalyzes the formation of S-adenosyltransferase (AdoMet) for methionine catabolism in the liver. MAT1A expression also correlates with a differentiated phenotype, whereas liver cells expressing MAT2A present a dedifferentiated phenotype and lowered AdoMet synthesis. Likewise, NFκB and TNFα cause a switch from MAT1A to MAT2A expression in human hepatocellular carcinoma (HCC), which facilitates cancer cell growth.
Purity	> 95% by SDS – PAGE.
Physical Appearance	Liquid.
Formulation	In 20 mM Tris-HCl buffer (pH8.0) containing 1mM DTT, 0.1M NaCl, 10% glycerol.
Concentration	0.5 mg/ml (determined by Bradford assay).
