Product Overview	Recombinant Human TAF1A was produced in E. coli.

Description	I2PP2A(β), also termed TAF-1, inhibits protein phosphatase 2A (PP2A) potently with $k_i \sim 0.1 - 0.5 \text{ nM}$ with myelin basic protein, histone H1 and other substrates but not with casein. It stimulates PP1 and regulates histone binding to DNA, transcriptional activity and chromatin condensation.
Purity	> 90% by SDS-PAGE, apparent $M_r \sim 41\text{-kDa}$.
Supplied	250 ng in 50 μ l 50 mM Tris-HCl pH 7.0 buffer containing 14 mM β -mercaptoethanol, 1 mM benzamidine, 0.1 mM phenylmethanesulfonyl fluoride, 1 mM EDTA and 0.1% Brij-35 and 10% glycerol.
Storage	Maintain preparations in aliquots at -70°C . Avoid repeated thawing.
