Description	Granzyme B (GzmB) is a serine protease that is involved in cytotoxic T lymphocyte-induced (CTL) cell death. It is reported to participate in the perforation of target cells and initiation of proteolysis that leads apoptosis. Similar to caspases, granzyme B preferentially cleaves substrate proteins with aspartic acid in the P1 position.
Form	Liquid. In TBS, 50% glycerol.
Specific Activity	≥7.0 units/μg protein.
Unit Definition	One unit is defined as the amount of enzyme that will hydrolyze 1 nmol Ac-IEPD-pNA per min 25°C, pH 8.0.
Toxicity	Standard Handling (MSDS available upon request).
Storage	≤ -70°C. Avoid freeze/thaw. Following initial thaw, aliquot and freeze (-70°C).

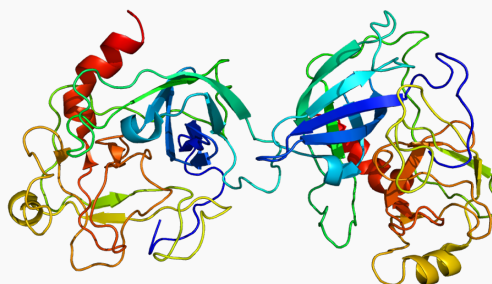
