Description	Human receptor Ephrin A8 (Ephrin type A receptor 8) functions as a receptor for ephrin A2, A3 and A5. Its extracellular domain contains a cysteine domain and 2 fibronectin type III repeats. It plays a role in development of the mammalian nervous system.
Concentration	0.33 mg/ml.
Molecular Weight	76.7 kDa.
Formulation	Liquid in 50 mM Tris, pH 7.5 + 150 mM NaCl + 0.5 mM EDTA + 0.02% Triton X-100 + 2mM DTT + 50% glycerol.
Storage	Stable for 6 months in working aliquots at -80°C. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
