Product Overview	A DNA sequence encoding the envelope glycoprotein E1 of Hepatitis C virus (subtype 1b, strain HC-J4) (AAC15725.1) (Tyr192-Ile340) was expressed with a polyhistidine tag at the N-terminus.

Description	E1 is a viral structural protein found in the hepatitis C virus. Hepatitis C virus (HCV or sometimes HVC) is a small (55–65 nm in size), enveloped, positive-sense single-stranded RNA virus of the family Flaviviridae. Hepatitis C virus is the cause of hepatitis C in humans.

Form	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4.1. Normally 5 % - 8 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization. Specific concentrations are included in the hardcopy of COA.2. Please contact us for any concerns or special requirements.
Molecular Mass	The recombinant envelope glycoprotein E1 of Hepatitis C virus (subtype 1b, strain HC-J4) consists 168 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 18.7 kDa.

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Endotoxin	< 1.0 eu per µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Purity	>95 % as determined by SDS-PAGE
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
