Product Overview	Recombinant human PDE10A (71-end) was expressed by baculovirus in Sf9 insect cells using an N-terminal GST tag.

Description	The protein encoded by this gene belongs to the cyclic nucleotide phosphodiesterase family. It plays a role in signal transduction by regulating the intracellular concentration of cyclic nucleotides. This protein can hydrolyze both cAMP and cGMP to the corresponding nucleoside 5' monophosphate, but has higher affinity for cAMP, and is more efficient with cAMP as substrate. Alternatively spliced transcript variants have been described for this gene.?
Form	Recombinant protein stored in 50mM Tris-HCl, pH 7.5, 150mM NaCl, 10mM glutathione, 0.1mM EDTA, 0.25mM DTT, 0.1mM PMSF, 25% glycerol.
Bio-activity	92 nmol/min/mg
Molecular Mass	~102 kDa
Purity	>80%

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Applications	PDE Assay
Stability	1 yr at -70oC from date of shipment.
Storage	Store product at –70oC. For optimal storage, aliquot target into smaller quantities after centrifugation and store at recommended temperature. For most favorable performance, avoid repeated handling and multiple freeze/thaw cycles.
Concentration	0.1 ug/ul
