Product Overview	Recombinant Human CD109, Val22-Ser1268 (Tyr703Ser & Thr1241Met), fused with a C-terminal 10-His tag, was expressed in Mouse NSO Cells.

Description	This gene encodes a glycosyl phosphatidylinositol (GPI)-linked glycoprotein that localizes to the surface of platelets, activated T-cells, and endothelial cells. The protein binds to and negatively regulates signalling by transforming growth factor beta (TGF-beta). Multiple transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for this gene.
Predicted N Terminal	Val22
Form	Lyophilized from a 0.2 µ filtered solution in PBS.
Bio-activity	Measured by its ability to bind TGF-beta 1 in a functional ELISA. Immobilized rhTGF-beta 1 at 1 µg/mL (100 µL/well) can bind rhCD109 with an apparent KD < 0.1 µM.
Molecular Mass	Predicted Molecular Mass: 141 kDaSDS-PAGE: 155-165 kDa, reducing conditions
Purity	>90%, by SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions and visualized by silver stain.

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Storage	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70 °C as supplied. 1 month, 2 to 8 °C under sterile conditions after reconstitution. 3 months, -20 to -70 °C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute at 100 µg/mL in sterile PBS.
Shipping	The product is shipped at ambient temperature. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended below.
