Storage	Lyophilized GFP although stable at room temperature for 3 weeks, should be stored desiccated below -18°C. Upon reconstitution GFP should be stored at 4°C between 2-

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7 days and for future use below -18°C. For long term storage it is recommended to add a carrier protein (0.1% HSA or BSA). Please prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized GFP in sterile 18MΩ-cm H₂O not less than 100µg/ml, which can then be further diluted to other aqueous solutions.

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
