Product Overview	Recombinant human CDKN3 protein, fused to His-tag at N-terminus, was expressed in <i>E.coli</i> and purified by using conventional chromatography techniques. MW = 25.9 kDa (232aa).

Description	Cyclin-dependent kinase inhibitor 3, also known CDKN3, belongs to the dual specificity protein phosphatase family. It was identified as a cyclin-dependent kinase inhibitor, and has been shown to interact with, and dephosphorylate CDK2 kinase, thus prevent the activation of CDK2 kinase. Also CDKN3 is important in cell cycle regulation.
Form	Liquid. In 20mM Tris-HCl buffer (pH 8.0) containing 1mM DTT, 40% glycerol, 0.1M NaCl.
Purity	> 90% by SDS - PAGE.
Concentration	0.5 mg/ml (determined by Bradford assay).

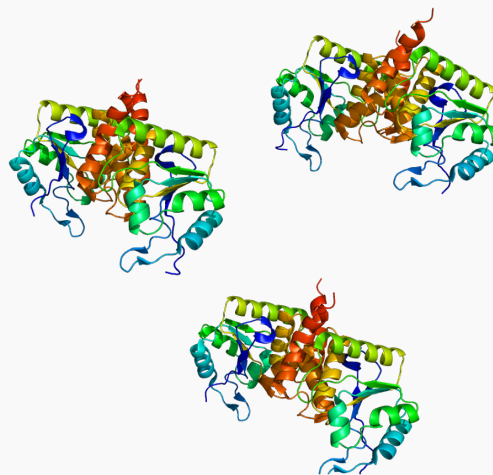
