Product Overview	Active Recombinant Human CST7 protein(NP_003641.3) (Met 1-His 145) was expressed in HEK293with a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus.

Form	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4.
Bio-activity	Measured by its ability to inhibit active Cathepsin L cleavage of a fluorogenic peptide substrate Z-LR-AMC. The IC50 value is <6 nM.
Molecular Mass	Cystatin F exists as a disulfide-linked homodimer. The human cystatin F monomer consists of 137 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 16.1 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, the recombinant Cystatin F migrates as an approximately 44 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under non-reduced conditions corresponding to the dimer.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU per µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Purity	> 92 % as determined by SDS-PAGE
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C upon receiving. Recommend to aliquot the protein into smaller quantities for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-

Reconstitution

It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
