Product Overview	Recombinant human PFDN1 protein, fused to His-tag at N-terminus, was expressed in E.coli and purified by using conventional chromatography. MW = 15.0kDa (130aa), confirmed by MALDI-TOF.

Description	PFDN1 is one of six subunits of prefoldin, a heterohexameric chaperone protein which assists in the correct folding of other proteins. This protein delivers nonnative target proteins, principally actins and tubulins, to the eukaryotic cytosolic chaperonin for facilitated folding. Defects in PFDN1 displayed phenotypes characteristic of defects in cytoskeletal function, including manifestations of ciliary dyskinesia, neuronal loss, and defects in B and T cell development and function.

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Storage

Can be stored at +4°C short term (1-2 weeks). For long term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or -70°C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles.
