Product Overview	Recombinant human HPD protein, fused to His-tag at N-terminus, was expressed in E.coli and purified by using conventional chromatography techniques. MW = 47 kDa (413aa) confirmed by MALDI-TOF.

Description	4-hydroxyphenylpyruvate dioxygenase isoform 1, also known as HPD, is an Fe-containing enzyme, that catalyzes the second reaction in the catabolism of tyrosine the conversion of 4-hydroxyphenylpyruvate to homogentisate. Existing as a homodimer, HPD uses zinc as a cofactor to catalyze the third step in the conversion of L-phenylalanine to fumarate and acetoacetic acid. Defects in the gene encoding HPD are the cause of tyrosinemia type 3 and hawkinsinuria, both of which are inborn errors of metabolism that are associated with a variety of symptoms, including mental retardation and seizures and hair and urine abnormalities.

Form Liquid. In 20mM Tris-HCl buffer (pH 8.0) containing 1mM DTT, 20% glycerol, 50mM NaCl.

Concentration 1 mg/ml (determined by Bradford assay).

Storage Can be stored at +4°C short term (1-2 weeks). For long term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or -70°C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles.
