Description	ALDOC, also known as aldolase C, is a member of the class I fructose-biphosphatealdolase family. This protein is a glycolytic enzyme that catalyzes the reversible aldol cleavage of fructose-1,6-biphosphate and fructose 1-phosphate to dihydroxyacetone phosphate and either glyceraldehyde-3-phosphate or glyceraldehydes respectively. It is expressed specifically in the hippocampus and Purkinje cells of the brain.
Form	Liquid. In 20mM Tris-HClbuffer(pH 8.0) containing 10% glycerol,2mM DTT, 0.1M NaCl.
Molecular Weight	41.6 kDa (384aa), confirmed by MALDI-TOF
Purity	> 95 % by SDS - PAGE

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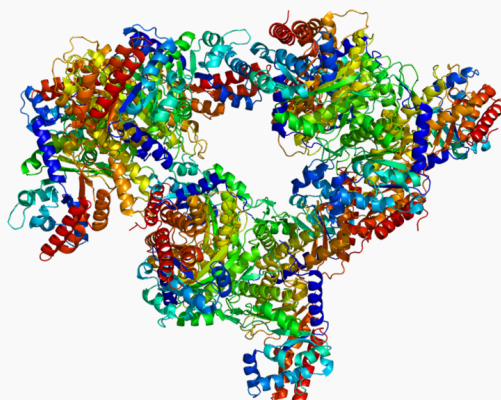
