Product Overview	Recombinant human PCNP protein, fused to His-tag at N-terminus, was expressed in E.coli and purified by using conventional chromatography techniques.

Description	PCNP (PEST proteolytic signal containing nuclear protein) is a nuclear protein implied to play a role in cell cycle regulation and tumorigenesis. This protein is ubiquitinated post-translationally by NIRF, an ubiquitin ligase. PCNP exists as three isoforms produced by alternative splicing events and may be involved in cell cycle regulation.

Storage
