Form	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, 10% Glycerol, pH 7.4. Please contact us for any concerns or special requirements. Normally 5 % - 8 % trehalose, mannitol and 0.01% Tween80 are added as protectants before lyophilization.
Molecular Mass	The recombinant human ATP5D consists of 161 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 16.9 KDa. It migrates as an approximately 17 KDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Purity	> 85 % as determined by SDS-PAGE
Storage	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20°C to -80°C. Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
