Product Overview	Recombinant E.coli ppa protein, fused to His-tag at N-terminus, was expressed in E.coli and purified by using conventional chromatography techniques (1-176aa).

Description	Inorganic pyrophosphatase (ppa) belongs to the Ppase family. This protein is an enzyme that catalyzes the conversion of one molecule of pyrophosphate to two phosphate ions. This is a highly exergonic reaction, and therefore can be coupled to unfavorable biochemical transformations in order to drive these transformations to completion. The functionality of this enzyme plays a critical role in lipid metabolism (including lipid synthesis and degradation), calcium absorption and bone formation, and DNA synthesis, as well as other biochemical transformations.
Form	Liquid. In 20mM Tris-HCl buffer (pH 8.0) containing 1mM DTT, 10% glycerol, 50mM NaCl
Molecular Weight	21.9kDa (196aa), confirmed by MALDI-TOF
Purity	> 95% by SDS - PAGE
