Description	Basic fibroblast growth factor (bFGF) is a member of the fibroblast growth factor (FGF) family. FGF family members possess broad mitogenic and cell survival activities, and are involved in a variety of biological processes, including embryonic development, cell growth, morphogenesis, tissue repair, tumor growth and invasion. This protein functions as a modifier of endothelial cell migration and proliferation, as well as an angiogenic factor. It acts as a mitogen for a variety of mesoderm- and neuroectoderm-derived cells in vitro, thus is thought to be involved in organogenesis.

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Reconstitution

It is recommended to re-dissolve the OsrhbFGF freeze-dried powder in sterile water to a concentration of 100-200 µg/ml. Other solvents can be used for further dilution. The dissolved OsrhbFGF can be stored at 4°C for 2-7 days. It should be used up as soon as possible. If not used for a short period, it should be stored at -20°C.
