Product Overview	Recombinant Human CCL8 protein(P80075-1) (Gln 24- 99) was expressed in E. coli, fused with the SUMO tag at the N-terminus.

Form	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4.
Molecular Mass	The recombinant human CCL8 consisting of 187 amino acids and has a calculated molecular mass of 21.7 kDa. The apparent molecular mass of the protein is approximately 30 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Purity	> 90 % as determined by SDS-PAGE
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C upon receiving. Recommend to aliquot the protein into smaller quantities for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
