SPECIFICATION

Product Overview	Human recombinant MIP-2 beta is produced in genetically engineered yeast, and purified by sequential chromatography.
Species	Human
Source	yeast
Description	This antimicrobial gene encodes a member of the CXC subfamily of chemokines. The encoded protein is a secreted growth factor that signals through the G-protein coupled receptor, CXC receptor 2. This protein plays a role in inflammation and as a chemoattractant for neutrophils.
Form	In 0.1M ammonium acetate at a concentration of 0.50 mg protein/ml
Bio-activity	The biological activity of recombinant human MIP-2 beta is determined by its use as a cofactor for CSF-dependent myelopoiesis.
Purity	Over 95% pure by SDS gel electrophoresis, with low level of endotoxin.
Stability	Several months at -80°C.
Storage	Store at -80°C.
