Product Overview	Recombinant Human KL(Glu34-Ser981), fused with a C-terminal 6-His tag, was expressed in Mouse NSO Cells.

Description	This gene encodes a type-I membrane protein that is related to beta-glucosidases. Reduced production of this protein has been observed in patients with chronic renal failure (CRF), and this may be one of the factors underlying the degenerative processes (e.g., arteriosclerosis, osteoporosis, and skin atrophy) seen in CRF. Also, mutations within this protein have been associated with ageing and bone loss.
Predicted N Terminal	Glu34
Form	Supplied as a 0.2 µ filtered solution in MES, Glycerol and EDTA.
Bio-activity	Measured in a cell proliferation assay using NIH-3T3 mouse embryonic fibroblast cells. The ED50 for this effect is typically 0.025 - 0.1 µg/mL in the presence of 1 µg/mL of rhFGF-23 and 10 µg/mL of Heparin. Measured in a cell proliferation assay using BaF3 mouse pro-B cells transfected with human FGF RIILc. The ED50 for this effect is typically 0.025 - 0.1 µg/mL in the presence of rhFGF-23 and Heparin.

Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU per 1 µg of the protein by the LAL method.
