Product Overview	Recombinant Human TREM1 protein(NP_061113.1)(Ala21-Arg200), fused with C-terminal His tag, was expressed in HEK293.

Form	Lyophilized from 0.22µm filtered solution in PBS (pH 7.4). Normally 5% trehalose is added as protectant before lyophilization.
Bio-activity	Human PGLYRP1, hFc Tag captured on CM5 Chip via Protein A can bind Human TREM1, His Tag with an affinity constant of 17.39 µM as determined in SPR assay (Biacore T200).
Molecular Mass	The protein has a predicted MW of 21.4 kDa. Due to glycosylation, the protein migrates to 40-60 kDa based on Tris-Bis PAGE result.
Endotoxin	Less than 1EU per µg by the LAL method.
Purity	> 95% as determined by Tris-Bis PAGE;> 95% as determined by HPLC

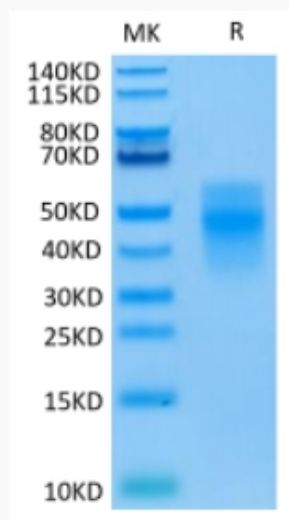
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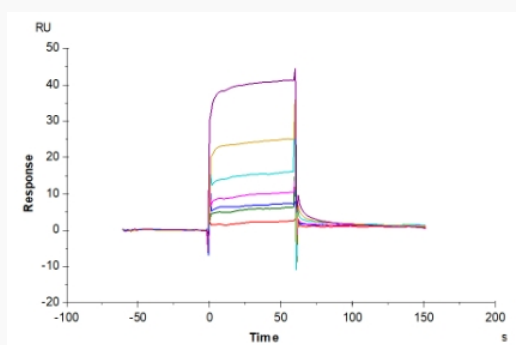

Storage	Reconstituted protein stable at -80°C for 12 months, 4°C for 1 week. Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	Centrifuge tubes before opening. Reconstituting to a concentration more than 100 µg/ml is recommended. Dissolve the lyophilized protein in distilled water.
