Description	This gene is a member of the iron/manganese superoxide dismutase family. It encodes a mitochondrial matrix protein that forms a homotetramer and binds one manganese ion per subunit. This protein transforms toxic superoxide, a byproduct of the mitochondrial electron transport chain, into hydrogen peroxide and diatomic oxygen. Alternate transcriptional splice variants, encoding different isoforms, have been characterized.
Research topic	Energy metabolism and body weight regulation
Storage	Superoxide dismutase 2 is supplied with a vial of storage buffer (20 mM Tris, pH7.5). Store at -80°C.
