Form	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4
Bio-activity	Measured by its binding ability in a functional ELISA. Immobilized human EFNA1-His at 10 µg/ml (100 µl /well) can bind human EPHA1-Fc, The EC50 of human EPHA1-Fc is 10-30 ng/ml.
Molecular Mass	The recombinant human EPHA1 consists 760 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 83.3 kDa.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU per µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method
Purity	> 90 % as determined by SDS-PAGE
Storage	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20°C to -80°C Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

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Reconstitution

It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
