Product Overview	Recombinant Mouse Vtcn1 (Accession # AAP37284) was produced in Mouse myeloma cell line, NS0-derived.
Species	Mouse
Source	Mammalian Cells
Predicted N Terminal	Phe29
Form	Lyophilized from a 0.2 µ filtered solution in PBS.
Bio-activity	Measured by its ability to inhibit anti-CD3-induced proliferation of stimulated human T cells. Human T lymphocytes cultured for 72 hours with PHA were incubated for an additional 3 days in 96 well plates coated with 500 ng/mL anti-CD3 and Recombinant Mouse B7-H4 Fc Chimera. The ED50 for this effect is typically 0.5 - 3 µg/mL. Optimal dilutions should be determined by each laboratory for each application.
Molecular Mass	Recombinant Mouse Vtcn1, Fc Chimera has a calculated MW of 52.4 kDa (monomer). In SDS-PAGE migrates as 75-85 kDa, reducing conditions.
Purity	>90%, by SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions and visualized by silver stain.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. No activity loss was observed after storage at: In lyophilized state for 1 year (4°C); After reconstitution under sterile conditions for 3 months (-70°C).
