Product Overview	Recombinant Human MAPK14 (Accession # NM_002613) , fused with an N-terminal His tag, was produced in baculovirus in Sf 9 insect cells.

Source	Sf9 Cells
Form	Supplied in 50 mM sodium phosphate (pH 7.0), 300 mM NaCl, 0.25 mM DTT, 150 mM imidazole, 0.1 mM PMSF, and 25% glycerol.
Bio-activity	The specific activity of PDK-1 was determined to be 125 nmol/min/mg using a synthetic peptide substrate
Molecular Mass	In SDS-PAGE migrates as 67 kDa.
Purity	The purity was determined to be >90% by densitometry
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. No activity loss was observed after storage at: In lyophilized state for 1 year (4°C); After reconstitution under sterile conditions for 3 months (-70°C).
