Molecular Mass	Recombinant Human TGM3, His-tagged has a calculated MW of 72 kDa. In SDS-PAGE migrates as 72 kDa, reducing conditions.
Purity	>95%, by SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions and visualized by silver stain.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. No activity loss was observed after storage at: In lyophilized state for 1 year (4°C); After reconstitution under sterile conditions for 3

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months (-70°C).

Reconstitute at 10 g/mL in sterile PBS containing at least 0.1% human or bovine serum albumin.
