Product Overview	Recombinant Human BMPR1A (Accession # NP_004320), fused with , was produced in Mouse myeloma cell line, NS0-derived.

Source	Mammalian Cells
Predicted N Terminal	Gln24 predicted: No results obtained, sequencing might be blocked
Form	Lyophilized from a 0.2 µ filtered solution in PBS.
Bio-activity	Measured by its ability to inhibit rhBMP-4-induced alkaline phosphatase production by ATDC5 mouse chondrogenic cells. Nakamura, K. et al. (1999) Exp. Cell Res. 250:351. The ED50 for this effect is typically 0.03-0.12 µg/mL in the presence of 30 ng/mL of Recombinant Human BMP-4.
Molecular Mass	Recombinant Human BMPR1A, Fc Chimera has a calculated MW of 40.8 kDa (monomer). In SDS-PAGE migrates as 59 kDa, reducing conditions.
Purity	>95%, by SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions and visualized by silver stain.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. No activity loss was observed after storage at: In lyophilized state for 1 year (4°C); After reconstitution under sterile conditions for 3 months (-70°C).
