Product Overview	Recombinant Human EPHA3 (Accession # NP_005224), fused with , was produced in Mouse myeloma cell line, NS0-derived.

Source	Mammalian Cells
Predicted N Terminal	Glu21
Form	Lyophilized from a 0.2 µ filtered solution in PBS.
Bio-activity	Measured by its binding ability in a functional ELISA. When Recombinant Human (rh) EphA3 Fc Chimera is coated at 2 µg/mL (100 µL/well), the concentration of biotinylated rhEphrin A5 Fc Chimera that produces 50% of the optimal binding response is found to be approximately 5 - 25 ng/mL.
Molecular Mass	Recombinant Human EPHA3, Fc Chimera has a calculated MW of 85.4 kDa (monomer). In SDS-PAGE migrates as 100-110 kDa, reducing conditions.
Purity	>95%, by SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions and visualized by silver stain.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. No activity loss was observed after storage at: In lyophilized state for 1 year (4°C); After reconstitution under sterile conditions for 3 months (-70°C).

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Reconstitution Reconstitute at 200 µg/mL in sterile PBS containing at least 0.1% human or bovine serum albumin.
