Form	Lyophilized from a 0.2 μ filtered solution in PBS.
Bio-activity	Measured by its binding ability in a functional ELISA. When rhSHH (2 μg/mL) is incubated with serial dilutions of rhCDO in solution, rhCDO binds rhSHH with an apparent KD < 30 nM.
Molecular Mass	Recombinant Human CDON, His-tagged has a calculated MW of 100.2 kDa. In SDS-PAGE migrates as 130-140 kDa, reducing conditions.
Purity	>85%, by SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions and visualized by silver stain.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. No activity loss was observed after storage at: In lyophilized state for 1 year (4°C); After reconstitution under sterile conditions for 3 months (-70°C).
