Product Overview	Recombinant Equine IL5 (Accession # O02699) Leu20-Gly134, fused with a C-terminal 6-His tag, was produced in Mouse myeloma cell line, NS0-derived.

Form	Lyophilized from a 0.2 µ filtered solution in PBS with BSA as a carrier protein.
Bio-activity	Measured in a cell proliferation assay using TF-1 human erythroleukemic cells. Kitamura, T. et al. (1989) J. Cell Physiol. 140:323. The ED50 for this effect is typically 4 - 16 ng/mL.
Molecular Mass	Recombinant Equine IL5, His-tagged has a calculated MW of 13.9 kDa (monomer). In SDS-PAGE migrates as 19 kDa, reducing conditions.
Purity	>95%, by SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions and visualized by silver stain.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. No activity loss was observed after storage at: In lyophilized state for 1 year (4°C); After reconstitution under sterile conditions for 3 months (-70°C).
