Product Overview	Recombinant Human EDIL3 (Accession # O43854) Val17-Glu480, fused with a C-terminal 6x His, was produced in Chinese Hamster Ovary cell line, CHO-derived.

Form	Lyophilized from a 0.2 μ filtered solution in PBS.
Bio-activity	Measured by the ability of the immobilized protein to support the adhesion of SVEC4-10 mouse vascular endothelial cells. When 5×10^4 cells/well are added to Recombinant Human EDIL3 coated plates (5 μg/mL, 100 μL/well), >45% will adhere after 60 minutes at 37 °C. Optimal dilutions should be determined by each laboratory for each application.
Molecular Mass	Recombinant Human EDIL3, His-tagged has a calculated MW of 52 kDa. In SDS-PAGE migrates as 60-65 kDa, reducing conditions.
Purity	>95%, by SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions and visualized by silver stain.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. No activity loss was observed after storage at: In

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lyophilized state for 1 year (4°C); After reconstitution under sterile conditions for 3 months (-70°C).
