Product Overview	Recombinant human CTSS was expressed by Human spleen.
Species	Human
Source	Human Spleen
Description	Like Cathepsins B, H, and L, CTSS belongs to the group of lysosomal cysteine proteinases. CTSS is found primarily in the spleen and in lung macrophages. Its level is elevated in the brain tissue of those with Alzheimer's disease and Down syndrome. CTSS may function in the processing of amyloid precursor protein to amyloid beta peptides.
Biological Activity	229.9 mU/mg using the method described by Kirche & Weiderlanders in Methods in Enzymology, 244.
Form	Lyophilized from 8.36 ul of 100 mM NaAc+1 mM EDTA, pH 5.5.
Appearance	Lyophilized
Reconstitution	Reconstitute in water to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/ml. This solution can then be diluted into other aqueous buffers and stored at 4°C for 1 week or -20°C for future use.
Storage	Store at -70°C, stable for at least 1 year as supplied. Avoid freeze/thaw cycles.

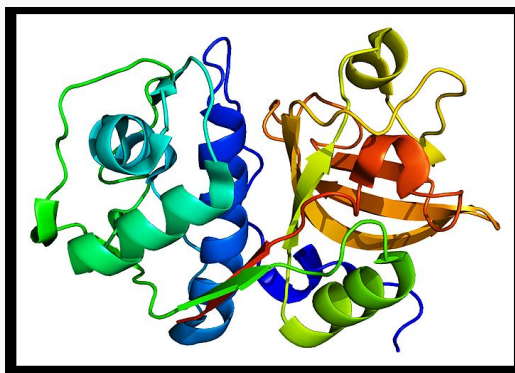
