Store working aliquots at 4 centigrade for up to one week.Small volumes of Apomucin,partial recombinant protein may occasionally become entrapped in the seal of the product vial during shipment and storage. If necessary, briefly centrifuge the vial on a tabletop centrifuge to dislodge any liquid in the container`s cap. Certain products may require to ship with dry ice.
Storage	Store at -20 centigrade, for extended storage, conserve at -20 centigrade or -80 centigrade.
