Product Overview	Recombinant Human POLB protein was a repair enzyme used to fill gaps and nicks in double-stranded DNA.

Form	20 mM Tris-HCl (pH 8.0), 0.1 mM EDTA. 200 mM NaCl, 1 mM dithiothreitol, 50% (v/v) glycerol
Unit Definition	One unit is the amount of enzyme required to incorporate 1 pmole of total nucleotide into acid-insoluble form in 60 minutes at 37 centigrade under the stated assay conditions.
Applications	1. Repair polymerase able to synthesize DNA beyond the end of a gap or nick with simultaneous displacement of the non-replicated strand.2. Fills gaps and nicks.
Notes	All preparations are assayed for contaminating endonuclease and exonuclease activities.
Storage	Store at -80 centigrade Long Term;Store at -20 centigrade.
