Product Overview	Recombinant Human AXL protein (Ala26-Pro449), fused to His tag at C-terminus, was expressed in human 293 cells (HEK293).

Description	AXL Receptor Tyrosine Kinase is also known as Tyrosine-protein kinase receptor UFO, which belongs to the protein kinase superfamily, Tyr protein kinase family and AXL/UFO subfamily. AXL contains two fibronectin type-III domains, two Ig-like C2-type (immunoglobulin-like) domains and one protein kinase domain. AXL is highly expressed in metastatic colon tumors. AXL is activated by GAS6-binding and subsequent autophosphorylation. AXL is involved in signal transduction from the extracellular matrix into the cytoplasm by binding growth factors, and thus implicated in the stimulation of cell proliferation.
Form	Lyophilized from 0.22 um filtered solution in PBS, pH7.4, 10% trehalose.
Molecular Mass	The protein has a calculated MW of 46.6 kDa. The protein migrates as 60-70 kDa under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE) due to glycosylation.
Endotoxin	Less than 1.0 EU per ug by the LAL method.

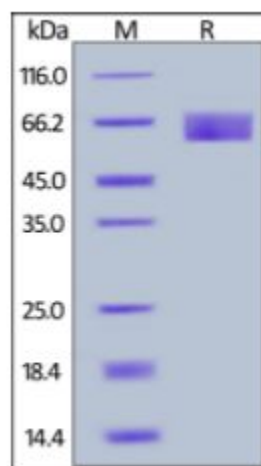
Purity	>95% as determined by SDS-PAGE.
Storage	For long term storage, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20 centigrade or lower. Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. This product is stable after storage at: -20 centigrade to -70 centigrade for 12 months in lyophilized state; -70 centigrade for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
