Product Overview	Full-length recombinant human TP73 alpha was expressed by baculovirus in Sf9 cells using an N-terminal GST tag.

Description	TP73 α is a member of the p53 family of transcription factors that are involved in cellular responses to stress and development. TP73 has high sequence similarity to p53 and p63, which allows p63 and TP73 to transactivate p53-responsive genes causing cell cycle arrest and apoptosis. TP73 is a stress-response gene and a downstream effector in the p53 pathway. The TP73 protein is expressed at very low levels in normal tissues and is differentially expressed in a number of tumors. TP73 is the components of a mismatch repair-dependent apoptosis pathway which contributes to cisplatin-induced cytotoxicity.

Storage	Store product at -70oC. For optimal storage, aliquot target into smaller quantities after centrifugation and store at recommended temperature. For most favorable performance, avoid repeated handling and multiple freeze/thaw cycles.
